- •Formal procedure

 Between 4 until 15 December 2006
- •Scope:

To assess whether the procedures have been respected and the set objectives and targets have been met

Implemented by:

Consulting Company (AQS)







3. Annual review (1)



- Formal procedure
- **18 December 2006**
- •Scope:
 - Assess the outcomes of internal audits
 - To review the EMS
 - To further improve the effectiveness of the system
 - To minimize any adverse effects
- Implemented by (Annual Review Report):

European Projects Office, Environmental Office, Quality and Human resources Office

3. Annual review (2)



- Commitments:
 - Adoption of the Municipality's revised environmental policy
 - Acceptance of the reformed Environmental program
 - Conducts of regular internal audits 3 times per year (every 4 months)
 - Expansion of EMAS in two additional departments
 of the Municipality (as indicated in the
 Municipality's Environmental Policy for ensuring
 the gradual expansion of EMAS in all the
 Municipality's departments)
