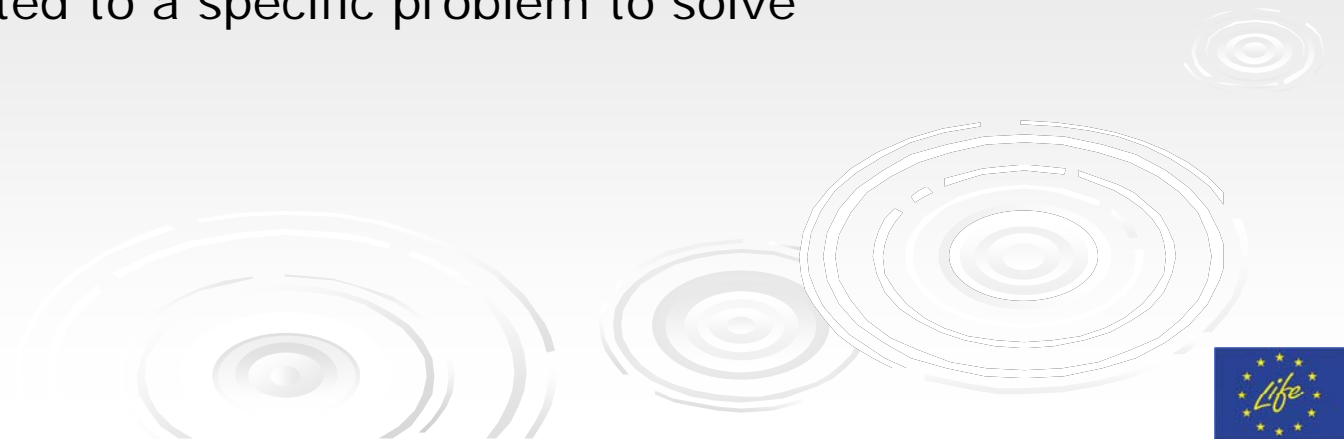


## 1) The “11 points model”

(what we planned, what we get so far, what we can improve)

The model can be used with 2 different approaches:

- Global approach: local authority faces all 11 points and proposed solutions, aiming at the implementation of one of the tools (EMAS, CLEAR, EcoBudget) or the integrated implementation of all of them
- Single point approach: local authority is interested in only one or few points related to a specific problem to solve
